

Plan a Vacation

For this activity you will be planning a vacation for you and your family. You can go anywhere you want; feel free to dream big. The more exotic your destination, the more varying your experiences are likely to be. You will be responsible for planning every phase of this trip.

Your Assignment

Your vacation plan will be broken into four parts - travel arrangements and lodging, maps, activities and entertainment, and itinerary. Each portion will need to be researched thoroughly, and your selection will need to be justified. The vacation will be eight days long. In other words, you will depart on one day and return on that same day (Saturday to Saturday).

Travel arrangements and Lodging

You will need to book round-trip transportation to your destination. Decide whether the convenience of a non-stop flight is worth the cost over a single or multi-stop flight. Is one room enough for everyone? Will you need a rental car where you're going? Are there other options? How will you get from the transportation center to your lodging?

Maps

Map out your vacation. Where are you going, and how far is it from your lodging? Are there multiple routes you can take to get there?

Activities and Entertainment

Find five different activities to do over the course of your vacation. Are there free options you can choose? What can you do that you don't have access to at home?

Itinerary

Now that you know where you're going, what you're going to do, and where things are, plan out your stay. Are some activities only available on certain days? Do you have an alternative in case it rains?
